## **SECOND NOTICE - INVITATION TO BID**

## REPAIR OF THE RESIDENCE OF THE AMBASSADOR IN TOKYO, JAPAN

 The Embassy of the Philippines in Tokyo, Japan, through the authorized appropriations under the General Appropriations Act and chargeable against Building Fund Program FY 2017 under ORS No. 06-17-06-04426 dated 19 June 2017, intends to apply the sum of Twenty Three Million One Hundred Ninety Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Philippine Pesos (PhP23,195,360.00) or Four Hundred Sixty Four Thousand US Dollars (US\$464,000.00), being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Repair of the Residence of the Ambassador located at 1-1 Fujimi, 1-chome, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo, Japan. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the bid opening.

- 2. Completion of the Works is required within Ninety (90) calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed without need of demand. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the project within Ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly in Section II, Instructions to Bidders (ITB).
- Bidding will be conducted through open bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", which may be downloaded at <u>www.gppb.gov.ph/laws/laws/RevisedIRR.RA9184.pdf</u>.
- 4. Interested Bidders may obtain further information from the Philippine Embassy in Tokyo, Japan and inspect the Bidding Document at the address given below from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from the address below and upon payment of non-refundable fee of **Twenty Five Thousand Pesos** (**PHP25,000.00**) at the cashier of the Philippine Embassy, Tokyo.

The bidding documents may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) www.gppb.gov.ph/downloadables/forms/PBD.GOODS.doc, provided that bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later that the submission of their bids.

- 5. The Philippine Embassy in Tokyo, Japan will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on 01 September 2017 at 2:00 P.M. at its Conference Room 1-B with address at 5-15-5 Roppongi, Minato-ku, Tokyo, Japan, which shall be open to all interested parties who have purchased the Bidding Document.
- 6. The sealed bids must be delivered to the address below on or before the date and time listed above. All sealed bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause18.
- 7. The opening of the sealed bids shall be done immediately after the deadline on the same date at the Conference Room 1-B with address at 5-15-5 Roppongi, Minato-ku, Tokyo, Japan. The sealed bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders or Bidders' representatives who choose to attend. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8. The Embassy reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
