**BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2023-006A**

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, TO THE HEAD OF POST OF THE PHILIPPINE EMBASSY IN TOKYO, JAPAN TO RESORT TO NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT FOR HIGHLY TECHNICAL CONSULTANT, AS AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT UNDER R.A. 9184, THE AWARD TO MARIA TERESA ORTIZ-MATERA OF LIT FASHION CONSULTANCY FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF HER SERVICES AS CONSULTANT AND EVENT ORGANIZER FOR THE PROJECT “HABI NATIN 2023 – TERNO EXHIBITION AND PHILIPPINE WEAVES LECTURE”.**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Embassy in Tokyo in cooperation with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) will hold a special program and exhibition of the “Terno” with a feature on Philippine textile and weaving named as “**HABInatin 2023- TERNO EXHIBITION AND PHILIPPINE WEAVES LECTURE**” on 12 and 13 June 2023 in commemoration of the Philippines’ Independence Day;

**WHEREAS**, Tokyo PE’s Cultural Section notes the importance of engaging the services of a consultant who can prepare the concept, curate and present *terno* collections in a visually appealing and creative manner, including bringing the *ternos*, expert lecturer and weaver from the Philippines to Japan;

**WHEREAS**, Tokyo PE intends to engage the services of consultant for the successful implementation of the Habinatin Project 2023;

**WHEREAS**, the planning and arrangement of the *terno* exhibit and lecture is included in Post’s Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP);

**WHEREAS**, this program is part of the activities covered by the Php7,000,000 funds from NCCA in its Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Embassy of Republic of the Philippines entered into on 1 June 2023;

**WHEREAS**, it intends to use the approved budget of **One Million Two Hundred Thousand Japanese Yen (¥1,200,000)**, chargeable against NCCA funds;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the *Government Procurement Reform Act* and its Implementing Rules and Regulations prescribe for the modernization, standardization and regularization of the procurement of the government;

**WHEREAS**, under Sec. 48 of R.A. 9184, any of the Alternative Methods of Procurement may be resorted to, subject to the prior approval of the Head of the Procuring Entity or his duly authorized representative, and whenever justified by the conditions provided in the Act, in order to promote economy and efficiency;

**WHEREAS**, under Sec. 21.2.1 of the IRR of R.A. 9184, the Procuring Entity may dispense with the advertisement in the newspaper and posting requirement when resorting to alternative methods of procurement;

**WHEREAS**, CIR-397-BAC-2018 dated 15 February 2018 and CIR-2354-OUA-2019 dated 15 October 2019 provided GPPB Resolution No. 28-2017 dated 31 July 2017, prescribing guidelines for overseas procurement of goods and services, infrastructure and consulting services;

**WHEREAS**, under the same resolution, Foreign Service Posts will not be required to post their procurement activities in the PHILGEPS website until the corresponding facility has become available through the PhilGEPS Modernization Project, the requirement of advertisement of procurement projects through newspapers was dispensed, as well as documentary requirements are relaxed to take into consideration the usual trade and business practices of the host country;

**WHEREAS**, under Sec. 53.7 of R.A. 9184, Negotiated Procurement is a method of procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting services, whereby the Procuring Entity directly negotiates a contract with a technically, legally, and financially capable supplier, contractor or consultant in case of individual consultants hired to do work that is (i) highly technical or proprietary; or (ii) primarily confidential or policy determining, where trust and confidence are the primary consideration for the hiring of the consultant; Provided, however that the term of the individual consultants shall, at the most, be on a six month basis, renewable at the option of the appointing HOPE, but in no case shall exceed the term of the latter;

**WHEREAS**, the services of Maria Teresa Ortiz-Matera for the HABInatin project in collaboration with NCCA; are highly technical or proprietary and fall under Sec.53.7 of R.A. 9184;

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Ortiz-Matera submitted an official quotation of **One Million One Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Japanese Yen (¥1,139,000)**, in accordance with the attached proposal/terms of reference;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC conducted due diligence inquiries on the selection of Maria Teresa Ortiz-Matera as consultant and event organizer for the HABInatin project and found her to be technically, legally, and financially capable service provider at the most advantageous price and contract for the Government.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in light of the foregoing considerations, WE, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** to:

Consultancy, for the procurement of her consultancy services for the Philippine Embassy's project "Habi Natin 2023 – Terno exhibition and Philippine weaves lecture on 12-13 June 2023, for the total amount of One Million One Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Japanese Yen (¥1,139,000).
